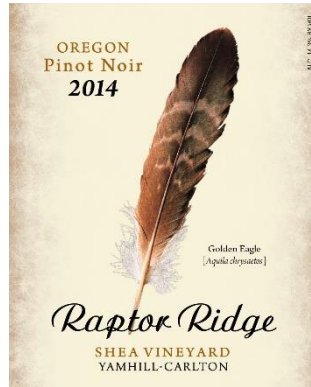


Raptor Ridge

Raptor Ridge's working history with this vineyard extends back to the earliest days of our winery, when, in 1996, Scott began sourcing ungrafted Pommard from Block 1. These days, Raptor Ridge draws its fruit from Block 11, midway up the East Hill, planted with clones 115 and 777 on 4409 rootstock. The structure of Shea usually permits long-term aging; we recently opened a bottle of 1997 Raptor Ridge Shea Vineyard that was still vibrantly alive!
